Food Bank Delivery

Food and money was delivered to the Campbell River Food Bank on Thursday by Jane Monchak, George Wagner, and Cathie Hall. We were warmly welcomed by Deb, the Manager, and given a full tour of the facilities.





Deb is the Food Bank Manager. Many people are unemployed or under-employed due to the pandemic and many of these families include children. The diapers, formula, and baby food we delivered will help these families. We also took a cheque for \$290 which enables the food bank to fill gaps.

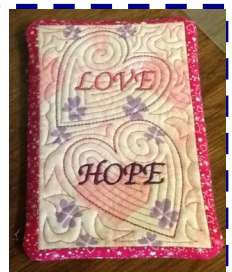
